### STAR OF TV SHOW Joins Brandon Tool Hire

Turn on the television these days, and it seems every other programme involves some unfortunate victim's house or garden being given a "makeover". The results are often interesting to say the least!

However, the majority of programmes have given viewers a chance to see in action, tools and equipment that would not usually reach such a large audience. A perfect example of this is the **Paslode Cordless Nailer**, used so effectively on a wide range of T.V. projects.

#### The Impulse IM350/90CTQ

Framing Nailer is the bigger of two machines, with a capacity to fix nails from 50mm to 90mm long. The range of nails includes Ring or Smooth Shank configurations, with coatings being Bright, Galvanised or Hot Dip Galvanised.

▶ frame erection, roof battening, fencing, stud partitioning and of course decking! This model weighs 3.1kg, is completely portable with no hoses or leads, and enables the quickest operators to fix up to three nails per second!

Weighing 2.5kg the Impulse IM250/65f16 is the smaller of the two, and ideally suited to second fix work such as fixing doorstops, architraves, T&G panelling and skirting boards, using nails and brads ranging from 19mm to 64mm long.

Both tools are powered by linear internal combustion motor. No hose or compressor; simply load with your choice of fastener, a fuel cell and a rechargeable battery, and they are ready to go to work. Every pack of

fastenings comes complete with fuel cells, each capable of *fixing 850 fasteners*. Once fully charged, one battery is able to fix 4,000 fastenings. The compact design allows you to work comfortably in cramped, overhead and other hard-to-reach places, and has proved extremely popular with a huge number of customers.

Recently, Dean Mullis, Manager of Brandon's Yeovil Branch supplied an IM350 to a local contractor, who was able to batten out a large roof on a house refurbishment project within a day! This was opposed to possibly three days' work by conventional methods.

Both machines carry a host of safety features, which prevent them from being operated unless pressed against a firm surface. ■
